




# User Manual

Inflatable Stand Up Paddle Board



# Parts of the board



# Inflating the board

The board's Air Valve is located near the aft end of the board.

1. Check so that the valve is closed. The centre valve pin (yellow) should be up. If it is down then press down on the valve pin and turn it anti-clockwise until it pops up.
2. Connect the pump hose to the "OUT" connection on the pump
3. Connect the pump nozzle to the valve on the board
4. Start pumping air into the board. The pump has two settings, use the high capacity setting to start with and then change it to high pressure setting when there is too much resistance to pump. **See instructions on the pump**
5. Do not over-inflate the board (Max:25psi). Pressure of 15 – 17 psi is adequate for use, leaving a margin for heat expansion when having the board in the sun.
6. Close the valve cover

# Attaching fins

Centre fin with screw attachment

1. Insert the square nut into the fin-box slot
2. Insert the aft end of the fin into the fin-box slot
3. Tighten the screw



Detachable thruster fins (not on all boards)

1. Insert the fin into the fin-box
2. Push the fin aft

Reverse to take off the fins

# Deflating the board

The board's Air Valve is located near the aft end of the board.

1. Open the valve by pushing the valve pin down and turn clockwise to lock in open position. **DON'T LOOK AT THE VALVE!** The first air comes out with high speed and pressure; turn your head away from the valve to prevent getting the air (and dust) in your eyes.
2. Leave the board for a minute or two to let most of the air out
3. Push out the rest of the air by rolling the board from the front towards the valve
4. When the air is out, close the valve by turning the valve centre pin anti-clockwise.
5. Close the valve cover

# Folding the board

Before storing, hose off the board and let it dry completely to prevent mildew build-up.

1. Detach the fins
2. Deflate the board using the Deflating the board instruction
3. Fold the board from aft end. If your board comes with fixed fins make sure the fin protection is in place
4. Tie the strap around the folded board for easier packing into the bag.
